

Freilassing Locomotive World

The Freilassing Locomotive World opened in 2006. With its outstanding locomotives it is a first class museum in the Berchtesgadener Land district. With its focus on technology and railway traffic the railway museum represents a special area in the museum landscape, one which has substantially defined Freilassing's history.

Not least, the authentic location of the site directly on the Munich – Salzburg railway line underlines the flair that the former railway depot has given to today's museum.

The fundamental features of the "Freilassing Locomotive World" museum are the wonderful, listed roundhouse (locomotive shed) on the one hand, and on the other the valuable locomotives on loan from the Transport Centre of the Deutsches Museum – a true seal of quality. The exhibition building and the exhibits are a perfect match.

A programme of regular high-quality events ensures that even those who already know the Locomotive World are always attracted back to the museum. The programme is always a well-balanced mix of railway-related and musical events. These include talks on the local railway history, special railway vehicle shows, the model railway weekend, the popular jazz brunches and Christmas in the Locomotive World.

Under the motto of "preserving the past and living in the present" the Freilassing Locomotive World is a special monument to and landmark in the railway town.
